## **Description**

The Project Intern is responsible for the implementation of advocacy, infrastructure and awarenessraising activities. The intern works under the supervision of the Programs Coordinators. The selected person will also be required to collaborate with other employees and volunteers.

He / she will be responsible for providing technical and administrative support, e.g.:

- Support the team in the implementation of projects and programs, such as: ensuring the proper functioning of the office, management of project-related information, negotiation support and meetings with partners, trainings, workshops and working meetings, drafting of minutes and other documents;
- Support the team in the search for funding and the analysis of potential donors;
- Prepare and organize project-related events;
- Perform other tasks at the request of the coordinators.

## Expertise

- Post-secondary education in the field of sustainable development, project management, social, economical or political sciences, other related field;
- Demonstrated interest in international cooperation, especially water issues;
- Computer skills;
- Good written and oral communication skills;
- Ability to work in a team and in collaboration with partners;
- Good knowledge of French and English (knowledge of Portuguese and / or Spanish would be an asset).

## The candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Be between the ages of 15 and 30 (inclusive) at the beginning of employment;
- Be enrolled as a full-time student during the previous year of study;
- Consider returning to full-time studies in the next academic year;
- Attend secondary, post-secondary, CEGEP (Quebec only), vocational or technical programs;
- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person who has been granted refugee protection under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act \*.
- \* International students are not eligible

Visible minorities and aboriginals are encouraged to apply.
